## 2. Purpose of Grant.

The 6th Annual Elk Valley Pride Festival is a 5-day celebration of diversity, inclusion, and Pride for 2SLGBTQ+ individuals and allies and takes place in Fernie, BC. The 6th annual celebration is scheduled for September 21-25, 2022 and will feature multiple live music opportunities, visual, literary, and performance arts events, educational opportunities, bike parades, opening cermony, and a myriad of other activities.

The Elk Valley Pride Festival format in 2022 will again be dictated by the current global pandemic and what is allowable for public events. In 2020 and 2021, we successfully hosted the Festival in a hybrid (virtual and in-person) format. The Elk Valley Pride Festival is the largest 2SLGBTQ+ event in the East Kootenay region and the 2021 edition had attendance of 1700 people for virtual events and 908 for in-person gatherings. Considering the gathering restrictions in 2021, this was a very successful event for the region. We anticipate the 2022 Elk Valley Pride Festival to welcome even more people over the course of the event.

The Festival takes place in universally accessible venues, offers $95 \%$ of its programming for free in order to ensure that the event is open to all regardless of economic status, welcomes people of all-ages to the majority of programming (there are two events that take place in liquor establishments after 9 pm ), and is focused on inclusion and equity for all residents and visitors to the region.

RDEK DGIA funding would be used to assist with the cost of Festival facility rentals and associated costs with the large, outdoor performance event - Spectrum Queer Arts Day - on the Saturday of the Festival (stage rental, sound/light tech, equipment rental, etc).

The Elk Valley Pride Festival will create connections for 2SLGBTQ+ individuals and foster awareness and acceptance of queer people and pertinent issues in the broader community. At its core, the Festival is a celebration but it is also an opportunity to educate, engage, and foster avenues of communication and collaboration for residents of, and visitors to, the Elk Valley.

The Fernie Pride Society formed in 2016 to address issues of visibility, connectedness, and social isolation of 2SLGBTQ+ individuals in the Elk Valley and surrounding area. These issues were identifed by resident queer people and their allies as they sought the methods in which to address these barriers to complete community participation. The Elk Valley Pride Festival is one initiative that the Fernie Pride Society has developed to address these barriers and design programs that work to remove or negate them.

The 2SLGBTQ+ community in the East Kootenay is not concentrated in any one community; any person that resides in or visits the Elk Valley will benefit from inclusivity, equity, and diversity initiatives. The Elk Valley Pride Festival is a 5-day celebration that works to promote inclusion and equity across all communities and in all aspects of civic, economic, and cultural participation.
