Subject	Cranbrook History Centre Heritage Railcar Preservation Building Project – Phase 2

REQUEST

Provide a Community Works Fund grant of \$250,000 to the Cranbrook History Centre to complete Phase 2 of the Heritage Preservation Building Project.

OPTIONS

- 1. THAT Community Works Funds of \$250,000 be granted to the Cranbrook History Centre to complete Phase 2 of the Heritage Preservation Building Project.
- 2. THAT the request for Community Works Funds from the Cranbrook History Centre to complete Phase 2 of the Heritage Preservation Building Project be denied.

RECOMMENDATION

Option 1

BACKGROUND/ANALYSIS

Phase 1 of the Heritage Railcar Preservation Building Project was completed in 2019, which constructed a 15,600 square foot roof covering 9 railcars. Phase 2 will see an additional 13,740 square feet of roofing and fully accessible platform constructed, serving the remaining 9 uncovered railcars.

Recognizing that Electoral Area C residents would benefit from the positive cultural and economic impacts of this project, Director Gay would like to contribute \$250,000 of Community Works Funds.

SPECIFIC CONSIDERATIONS

Financial – Taxation

There would be no effect on taxation due to the funding being provided through Community Works Funds.

Community Works Fund – Funds Available

The uncommitted balance of the Community Works Fund is \$3,240,013.

Community Works Fund Eligible Project Category

This project meets the criteria outlined in the Community Works Fund agreement under the Cultural Infrastructure – Infrastructure Supporting Heritage Category.
