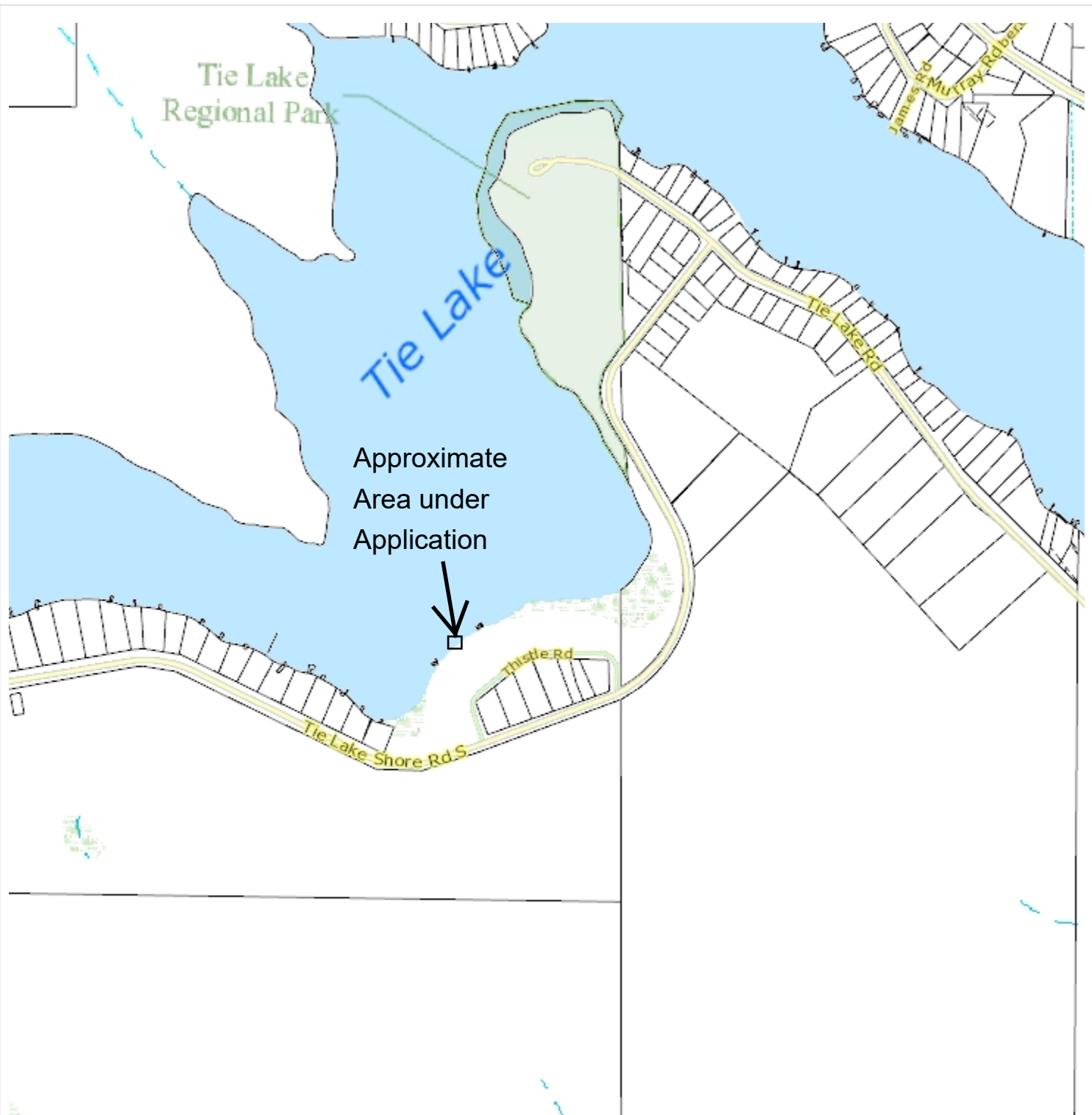


Location Map

Re: Thistle Road Owners Group Society (MoTI File: 2013-03902)

The Ministry of Transportation and Infrastructure (MoTI - Rocky Mountain District) has been requested to provide a letter of support as the upland property owner for a group moorage application on Tie Lake with access via Thistle Road Right of Way.
